Starting in 2024

The sale of new gas-powered leaf blowers, lawn mowers and other landscaping equipment will be banned in California.¹



By 2035

Gas-powered cars and trucks will be banned, with bans starting as soon as 2026. ²





Through 2050,

The U.S. Department of Energy makes clear that oil & gas will be the most consumed source of energy. This is well past when gas-powered cars & trucks are banned here in California. ³

In 2022, a survey of 800 Latinos in California asked about the new policies related to banning gas-powered cars and equipment and transitioning to fully electric cars. ⁵



of respondents agree that ideas to improve air quality and fight climate change only work if they are affordable for everyone.



of Latinos agreed that California can continue to lead in providing clean air, it will only happen if we are given enough time.



of Latino respondents agree that these proposals discriminate against lower income Californians who are unable to afford electric cars or electric lawn mowers.



of Latinos surveyed agree that the cost of living in California is already extremely expensive and that middle and low-income Californians will get hit the hardest by these extreme policies.
